











A pharmacy residency is a paid experience that enhances your confidence and abilities, making you more competitive in the job market for a wide variety of specialty career paths. Residency training provides the opportunity to complete one to two years of advanced training in patient care, interprofessional healthcareprovider




Highlighting your skills & qualities in the interview
